Child Protection Behavioural Guidelines

In addition to our broad expectations for child safe behaviour in all College environments stated in the College's Child Safety Code of Conduct, and the specific professional boundaries guidelines in our Staff and Student Professional Boundaries policy, the College has developed the following matrix of policies and guidelines to clearly outline expected standards of child safe behaviour within the College in the specific circumstances.

The Child and Youth Risk Management Strategy Toolkit outlines a number of behavioural issues for the College to consider and requires the College to develop policies or guidelines which clearly outline the expected standards of behaviour within the College relating to these issues. Djarragun College's Child Safety Code of Conduct and Staff and Student Professional Boundaries policy cover many of these issues, however the following behavioural issues require more in-depth and specific guidelines and, as such, the College has developed specific policies to address them.
