APPLICANTS FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS MUST
COMPLETE THE DJARRAGUN COLLEGE
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

#### **CRITERIA**

- Open to all current and new students entering Djarragun College.
- Scholarship applications will need to be completed by:
- ROUND ONE: 21 January / ROUND TWO: 15 August
- Late applications will be accepted, if a position is available, until: ROUND ONE: 31 January / ROUND TWO: 31 August
- Notification of successful students by:
- ROUND ONE: 18 February / ROUND TWO: 15 September

#### **PROCESS**

- Applications must be received by: ROUND ONE: 21 January / ROUND TWO: 15 August
- Applicants who are short listed will be notified and asked to meet with the College Registrar for an interview.
- The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the College. No award shall be granted if, in the opinion of the College, no candidate is of sufficient merit.

#### **AWARD**

- The scholarship will entitle the successful applicant/s to \$500 of fee relief at the end of Term 2 and a further \$500 fee relief at the end of Term 4. Total value of \$1,000 fee relief.
- An annual review of successful recipients will occur in December

#### **EXPECTATIONS**

- The successful applicant/s may be asked to speak at a College assembly or gathering.
- The successful applicants will be photographed and acknowledged in the College publications and on the website.
- The successful applicants will uphold the behaviours of the Djarragun Way.

The Djarragun College Scholarships are funded by the generous support of the Diarragun College Board. The scholarships seek to offer places to students who will contribute to the richness and diversity of the College community. The Skilled and Deadly scholarships are for all new and current students entering Year 10 and Year 11 and the Empowered Leaders are offered for scholarships students in Primary - Year 4, Year 5 & Year 6 and Secondary -Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9.
